## Tournament of Champions & Interclub Challenge

### TOURNAMENT OF CHAMPIONS

**Eligibility:** Amateur club champions from the Triad Golf Today circulation area and winners of other qualifying tournaments of at least two days by players from Triad clubs. Does not have to enter with team.

**Format:** Two-day medal play. Sudden death playoff for first place only.

### INTERCLUB CHALLENGE

**Eligibility:** Each club champion is invited to bring a team consisting of himself and three other amateur club members or association members. Ideally, players who finished 2-3-4 in the club championship tournaments should be invited. If they are unable to attend, the champion can bring three players who were club members or association members from the club at the time of last year's club championship. The alternates must be approved by tournament officials. If the club champion can not attend, the club runner-up or a club official is responsible for assembling the team.

**Format:** Two bestball. The best two scores of four will be counted on each hole. Third bestball from the second round will be used to break first-place tie. Other ties broken on scorecard playoff using Sunday first ball.

### CHALLENGER FLIGHT

**Eligibility:** Team members who are not eligible for T of C.

**Format:** Two-day medal play. Sudden death playoff for first place only.

**Cut:** There will be a cut after the first round to players who are within 10 shots of the leading score of this flight or the top 20 players and ties. Players who do not make the cut will still play in Sunday's round for team scores but no individual score will be taken. The Interclub flight winner qualifies for the 2010 Tournament of Champions.

**PRIZES:** (based on full field of 104 players). Prize pool could be less, depending on number of entries. Prizes are gift certificates at Greensboro National Golf Club.
